GM Cars w/Powermaster Boosters Master Cylinder Fluid Level

General Motors vehicles using their own "Powermaster" boosters require special procedures to check master cylinder fluid levels. Failure to properly check a GM vehicle's fluid level can lead to overfilling, resulting in fluid loss through the vents.

Here's how to check the fluid level correctly:

- 1. With the ignition switch turned off, apply medium force to the brake pedal ten times and then release. This will allow fluid from the accumulator to return to the reservoir.
- Clean the area around the master cylinder cover to keep dirt from getting into the reservoir.
- Remove the reservoir cover and check the fluid level. It should register between the high and low marks on the fluid level indicators in the reservoir.
- 4. Add fluid as necessary, being sure to use brake fluid meeting DOT 3 requirements or better.
